UPSTART pressed the pace of BLUEGRASS SINGER from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the three-eighths marker, vied into the stretch, opened a clear lead soon after and drew off with compete authority. FROSTED was bumped at the break, stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to be clearly second best. BLUEGRASS SINGER set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged by the winner nearing the three-eighths pole, vied into the stretch and gave way to that rival. JUAN AND BINA appeared hard to rate early, settled just off the leaders, moved outside through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. KEEN ICE was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch but lacked the needed rally. FRAMMENTO was void of early speed, saved ground into the stretch and failed to menace. FIRST DOWN pressed the pace from between rivals and weakened after going three-quarters. DECISION DAY raced far wide through the first turn, was forwardly placed early and gradually weakened. HIGH NOON RIDER was bumped at the break, lacked early speed, raced off the rail through the second turn, was pulled up approaching the stretch and walked off.
