## **Footnotes**

SHAGAF, rated along the inside to the quarter pole, was given his cue angling sharply three wide into the stretch, came out slightly after some left side pressure to meet an incoming ADVENTIST, himself after being given some right side pressure, in the vicinity of the eighth pole, lost no momentum from that fleeting incident, continued onward, forging to the front well inside the sixteenth marker, went across the wire sufficiently in the clear but having drifted out into the five path. LAOBAN lost his footiing springing from the gate, yet managed to out-break practically all the others, was intially on the receiving end of some brisk urging establishing control, shook off RALLY CRY's abbreviated challenge midway down the backstretch, faced a much stiffer and more prolonged bid from SUNNY RIDGE beginning from approximately the five-sixteenths pole, gamely rebuffed it, relinquished to the winner with under a sixteenth to go, but had enough left to garner the place. ADVENTIST took up the chase mostly in the two path for almost three-quarters, was let out a notch out-racing CONQUEST BIG E for path three approaching the five-sixteemths marker, made some light and abbreviated contact with that foe while doing so, got set down spinning four wide into the stretch, came in slightly after a solitary right handed shot just as the winner was moving towards him from the inside, took hold for a jump while shying back back in the direction of the middle of the strip, all this occurring in midstrech, continued onward in a willing manner for the show award. SUNNY RIDGE travelled three wide on both turns, ranged up to issue a challenge for command as six furlongs was being reached, kept up that strong bid to midstretch before weakening. CONQUEST BIG E swung three wide onto the backstretch, lost that path to ADVENTIST after rubbing shoulders with that rival coming to the five-sixteentsh pole, began the stretch being two wide with little left and gave way. RALLY CRY off last, rushed up three then two wide into a contending position by the time the first fraction had been recorded, advanced enough to hitch up to the pacesetter shortly after entering the backstretch, got flicked off, departed the backstretch still two wide but now between rivals, would remained positioned in the middle of others for anoher furlong, was put to encouragement but gave way after completing three-quarters. VINCENTO pulling on the bit for a portion of the way to the crown of the clubhouse turn, worked out a tuck along the inside, continued to hug the rail on the far turn, was put to the whip at the midway point, failed to respond and steadily backed away.
