Footnotes

GORMLEY a bit washy at the gate, was between horses early, stalked off the rail, bid outside the runner-up to duel for the lead, took a short advantage into the stretch, fought back outside that one through a stiff drive and gamely prevailed under urging. AMERICAN ANTHEM sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then dueled along the fence, came out a bit into the stretch, fought back along the rail in the final furlong and went on gamely to the end. BIG HIT pulled between horses and steadied early, went three deep into the first turn then stalked off the rail or outside a rival, continued off the inside on the second turn and bested the others. BIRD IS THE WORD between horses early, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came outside a rival into the stretch and weakened. TERM OF ART settled inside, went outside a rival on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. COLONEL SAMSEN between horses early, chased inside, cut the corner into the stretch and had little left for the drive. BLABIMIR bobbled at the start, went up four wide into the first turn, stalked off the rail, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch but walked off. GORMLEY and BIG HIT wore calks.
