Footnotes

SIYOUMA (IRE) was under strong rating while in range throughout, closed three-wide into the stretch, swept by the leaders with authority 3/16th out and held sway under a hand ride. PAGERA (FR), in touch while saving ground, moved out between rivals upper stretch, launched her bid but was outkicked. DREAM PEACE (IRE), in midpack early, was in touch on the far turn, chased into the stretch and finished determinedly. KISSABLE (IRE) settled in midpack, was hustled three-wide on the far turn and rallied gamely. HAVANT (GB), away slowly, settled well off the pace, closed leaving the far turn and rallied widest. BAREFOOT LADY (IRE) raced in midpack, saved ground, was all out along the rail in the stretch but evened out in the late stages. MOMENT OF MAJESTY raced off the pace but in hand, saved ground, chased into the stretch then finished determinedly between rivals. ALL STAR HEART settled off the pace in hand, chased three-wide into the stretch then tendered a mild late run. STARS TO SHINE stalked the pace, closed up and was lapped on to the leader entering the far turn, chased hard into the stretch and tired. PRINCESS HIGHWAY raced in midpack, chased four-wide into the stretch then evened out in the final 16th. TROIS LUNES (FR), rated in midpack, was hustled four-wide into the stretch, was squeezed back from between rivals a furlong out then chased to the wire. KAPITALE (GER) took command approaching the backstretch, set a pressured pace then tired midstretch. VAMO A GALUPIAR (CHI) stalked the pace to late turn and backed away.
