Footnotes

CLOUD COMPUTING drafted in towards the rail nearing the wire the first time and tracked firmly in hand, eased out and was put to pressure mid way on the final turn, brushed with ALWAYS DREAMING soon into the lane, came in briefly when put to the right stick three sixteenths from home, corrected and responded when roused once left handed, closed in under solid hand encouragement and collared CLASSIC EMPIRE a sixteenth out, assumed a short lead with about fifty yards to go and held firm. CLASSIC EMPIRE bobbed slightly at the break but quickly recovered and was sent to engage ALWAYS DREAMING from his outside, prompted in hand, disposed of that rival and went clear near the five sixteenths, was under strong encouragement into the lane, dug in gamely through the final sixteenth but just could not deny the winner. SENIOR INVESTMENT, fractious in the saddling area, settled well off the early pace and off the inside, steadied briefly near the far turn, angled out and circled six wide into the lane, straightened and kept on willingly to gain the show. LOOKIN AT LEE leaned in causing an awkward break, dropped in early and lagged well back, was under pressure three wide near the far turn, angled five wide for the drive and kept trying to the wire. GUNNEVERA saved ground under urging, gained into the lane, worked through a bit of a tight spot when angling closer to the rail near the three sixteenths, pursued the top pair past the furlong grounds then flattened out. MULTIPLIER was unhurried while saving ground, gained along the fence near the quarter pole, angled out soon after, lost a bit of momentum nearing the eighth pole, regrouped and churned on between rivals. CONQUEST MO MONEY, three to four wide under coaxing, commenced a run leaving the far turn, continued steady progress under a drive to upper stretch, failed to sustain leaving the three sixteenths, drifted in briefly and faded. ALWAYS DREAMING brushed the outside of the gate and

had his rider briefly adjust his right iron, straightened, secured the rail and was hounded by CLASSIC EMPIRE, could not go with that rival leaving the three eighths, shifted out chasing into the lane, brushed with the winner then gave way. HENCE , off the pace two to three wide, was under strong urging leaving the far turn but failed to respond. TERM OF ART was sent from the gate to gain a forward spot, chased the leaders three wide, could not keep pace nearing the five sixteenths and gave way.
