BLIND LUCK drifted in at the start, was outrun for a half, waited briefly with three furlongs to go rather than moving out seven or eight wide, made a run six wide approaching the stretch and closed fast to be up in the final stride. EVENING JEWEL angled in when forwardly placed to be off the inside, moved out a bit and advanced after six furlongs, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but missed. TIDAL POOL set the pace off the inside, saved ground on the second turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened late. BEAUTICIAN drifted out at the start, was reserved for a half, made a good four wide middle move but had little left late. AILALEA closest to the pace three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. AMEN HALLELUJAH in close quarters on the first turn in traffic, recovered to race in good position to the stretch but weakened. CRISP steadled when forced in at the start, regained some position four wide on the first turn, made a good five wide middle move but tired in the drive. QUIET TEMPER outrun along the inside, was no real threat. IT'S TEA TIME within striking distance along the inside, tired. JOANIE'S CATCH forwardly placed three wide, moved out a path on the second turn and faded in the stretch. CHAMPAGNE D'ORO forced in at the start, raced in traffic on the first turn and never menaced. AGE OF HUMOR close up along the inside, stopped. JODY SLEW could not menace. BELLA DIAMANTE forced in at the start, was outrun.
