



WOODMANS LUCK angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail into and on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up on the wire and become the final winner at Hollywood Park. DEPRECIABLE angled in and stalked outside a rival or off the rail, continued three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage in upper stretch, kicked clear but was caught on the line. DANDEREK (GB) chased a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some and continued willingly for the show. MR. CANDY BAR chased between horses then outside a rival, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ANYTHINGSCOOKIN had good early speed and dueled between horses then inside on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the final furlong. SO ELITE settled between foes then came out into the backstretch, chased outside, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. INSIDEONDOUTSIDE angled in and dueled three deep then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. SOUL CANDY broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled inside then just off the rail, split rivals in midstretch and lacked the needed rally.

POSHSKY chased between horses then outside a rival, went three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. MOONLIT METEOR stalked inside then between horses leaving the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, found the inside in the stretch and weakened. TWIN SIX broke a bit slowly, chased three deep then outside a rival or between foes, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. TOMMY DANZIGGER pulled his way along to press the pace inside then stalked on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the drive.
